
CHRISTMAS SHOPPING

Don't leave picking a live tree until too late. Shop around to






finalise numbers early on. Also consider any dietary requirements so you can shop for alternatives.

If you like to go all out for Christmas meals, make sure you






beer, cider and whatever else tickles your fancy.

That takes away a huge chunk of stress come Christmas day!




Whatever your method, make sure to label each present as soon as it's wrapped then organise them clearly - individual santa sacks are always a good idea.

You might like wrapping presents as you buy them, or you


could wait until Christmas eve to wrap them all in one go.




